Swimming

The Sports Grant was also used to fund swimming lessons with 'Supersharkey's Swim School'. Our pupils do not swim regularly outside of school due to cultural and time constraints because they attend mosques in the evening.

This academic year we have been able to fund swimming lessons for Year 3 and 4.

100% of the cohort were non swimmers September 2018.

100% of Year 3 pupils are now water confident or can swim at least 5 metres

Year 6 Pupils: -

Currently 34% of Year 6 pupils can swim 25m or more with a range of strokes

0% can perform safe and rescue.

Next Steps Swimming: -

The Sports Grant will continue to fund 'Supersharkay's Swim School' in Year 3 and 4 to ensure the pupils in Year 3 when they move to Year 4 develop their swimming further and to offer swimming lessons to the new Year 3 pupils.

To celebrate the pupils' swimming achievements by funding their swimming badges and certificates.

To increase the number of pupils by the time they leave KS2 to be able to swim 25m or more.
