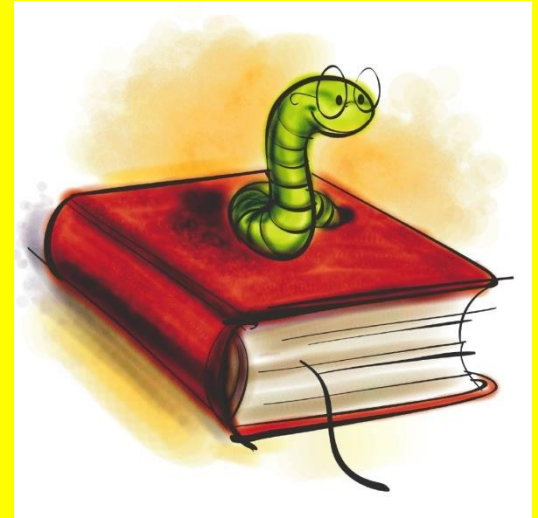
WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENT SECTIONS OF A STORY STRUCTURE?
