<u>Monday</u> <u>5.7.21</u>	Practice reading and spelling words from the spelling list.	Last week in Maths we practiced rounding numbers to the nearest 100. Choose your own 3 digit numbers. Write what they would round to, to the nearest 100. Remember, if the number ends in 1-49, round it down; if it ends in 50-99, round it up. E.g. 233 rounds down to 200; 776 rounds to 800 etc.	Read and discuss ‘Jade’s party’ with someone else in your house. Answer the ‘questions to read and answer’ on the last slide.	Last week you planned your story about Robert and Nita, the room-cleaning robots. Today, read the slide about how Robert and Nita are getting fed up of cleaning. Discuss your ideas with someone else in your house, about what they might say to each other. Then, over the next 2 days, you are going to draw a comic strip to show their conversation. You can either use the template provided, or draw your own version. Remember to draw speech bubbles to show what they say!
<u>Tuesday</u> <u>6.7.21</u>		Solve the subtraction questions by counting up to find the difference. Look at the pictures to help you. Then solve the word problems. EXT: Answer the ‘think’ question.	Read ‘Jade’s party’ again. Complete the comprehension questions about it. Use the sentence starters to help you.	
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>7.7.21</u>		As yesterday, solve the subtraction questions by counting up to find the difference. Then solve the word problems. EXT: Answer the ‘think’ question.	Read and discuss p9-17 of ‘Living Dinosaurs’ with someone else in your house.	Today you are going to rewrite your conversation between Robert and Nita using inverted commas. Read the information about inverted commas in the PowerPoint first, so you know what to do. Then rewrite your conversation using the correct punctuation. Don’t forget to use ‘I’ and ‘we’ when writing, as you are pretending to be Robert!
<u>Thursday</u> <u>8.7.21</u>		Solve the subtraction questions by counting up.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.	Read the PowerPoint slides which show an example story about Robert and Nita. Then complete the story map template, showing what is going to happen in your story. You can draw pictures and write your ideas. Remember to show the main events in your story.
<u>Friday</u> <u>9.7.21</u>	Complete a spelling test of the some of the words that you have practiced this week.	Solve the subtraction questions by counting up to find the difference. Then solve the word problems. EXT: Answer the ‘think’ question.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.	Look at your story map from yesterday. Rewrite your ideas for your story using the planning template. Think about what will happen in each part. Remember, this is just a plan – not the whole story – so you only need to make notes!
