(eg: 458 x 3, 583 x 4 and so on)</p> <p>Use the grid method to work these out.</p> <p>When you think you have found all the calculations try another 4 digits.</p>	<p>Bug club - read one of your allocated stories and complete the questions</p>	<p>You have your draft from yesterday. Ask an adult to read it with you and together come up with ways you could improve. Maybe the adult can tell you about some of your spelling mistakes, they might listen to you read your work and suggest words that might sound better.
