Remember to	Write multiplication and division facts to make each number. E.g. $1 \times 8 = 8$ $8 \times 1 = 8$ $2 \times 4 = 8$ $4 \times 2 = 8$ $8 \div 1 = 8$ $8 \div 8 = 1 \dots\dots$ etc	Read the text ‘The history of the Olympic Games’. Answer the questions about it.	This week in Literacy we are going to revise some of the skills that we have learnt this year. Sort the sentences based upon whether they are statements (telling you something), commands (telling you to do something), questions (asking you something) or exclamations (something surprising/exciting). Then write an example of each kind of sentence, about your dream summer holiday.

Remember you show the remainder by writing r before the leftover amount, e.g. $21 \div 5 = 4 \text{ r } 1$.	Read the text ‘Celebrating the NHS’. Answer the questions about it.	Look at the postcards. Write a prepositional phrase about each one, e.g. ‘The beach ball is on the sand’. Use the word bank to help you. Then, write a postcard about your dream holiday, including prepositional phrases.
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>14.7.21</u>		Complete the division questions. Then fill in the missing numbers in the questions. EXT: Answer the ‘think’ question.	Choose a book to read from home. Talk about it with someone in your house.	Read the letter sent home by the teacher. Rewrite it, correcting the mistakes that she has made. Watch out for homophones (words that sound the same, but have different spellings/meanings, e.g. deer/dear, maid/made etc).

Read the text about Granny French. Add in the missing plural words. Remember, plural means more than one – e.g. ‘child’ becomes ‘children’, ‘suitcase’ becomes ‘suitcases’ etc.
