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| <u>Monday</u> <u>19.4.21</u> | Practice reading and spelling the words with the prefixes ‘dis’, ‘in’ and ‘un’. | Answer the questions about the 5 and 10 times tables. Challenge: Answer the word problems (questions 13-16). | Read and discuss ‘The Naughty Boy’ with someone else in your house. Answer the questions about it. | Look at the picture of the seaside and imagine that you are there. Write sentences to describe what you can see, hear, smell and feel. Use the word bank and sentence starters to help you. |
| <u>Tuesday</u> <u>20.4.21</u> | | Answer the questions about the 4 x table. Challenge: Answer the ‘think’ question. | Practice the ‘air’ sound and read the linked words. Read and discuss ‘Hairy fairy’ with someone else in your house. | Read your writing from yesterday again. Edit and improve it, using a different coloured pen. Think about where you could add in adjectives/adverbs etc. Then rewrite a final draft, using the sandcastle themed lined paper. |
| <u>Wednesday</u> <u>21.4.21</u> | | Answer the questions about the 3 x table. Challenge: Answer the ‘think’ question. | Write sentences to describe the hairy fairy. Think about what he looks like, what his job is, how other people feel about him etc! | Read ‘Sand Wizards’ again. Make a word cloud of words that you think are important in the story. Look at the example to help you. |
| <u>Thursday</u> <u>22.4.21</u> | | Halve the numbers using partitioning (splitting the numbers into tens and ones, e.g. $24 = 20 + 4$). Challenge: Answer the ‘think’ question. | Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it. | You might want to reread ‘Sand Wizards’ to refresh your memory, before starting today’s work. Read the sentences taken from the story (A, B and C). Describe how you think Cole is feeling at these different points of the story, and why. Remember to write in full sentences! |
| <u>Friday</u> <u>23.4.21</u> | | Complete a spelling test using some of the words with the prefixes ‘dis’, ‘in’ and ‘un’. | Answer the questions, halving the numbers using the same method as yesterday. Challenge: Answer the word problems (questions 19, 20 and the ‘think’). | Answer the questions about the story. Use the sentence starters and word bank to help you. Then complete the EXT. |
