	<u>Spellings</u>	<u>Maths</u>	<u>Reading</u>	<u>Writing</u>
<u>Monday</u> <u>28.6.21</u>	Practice reading and spelling words from the spelling list.	Write the capacity shown in each jug. (Tip: the scales go up in 50s!) <u>EXT</u> : Label the jug in 50ml intervals. Draw a line across the jug to show 350ml.	Practice the ‘ay’ and ‘a-e’ sounds and read the linked words. Then read and discuss ‘Jade’s party’ with someone else in your house.	Today you are going to plan a new story about the robots Robert and Nita, from ‘A tale of two robots’. If you need to reread the story to refresh your memory, you can find a copy of it in last week’s home learning section. Read the ideas on the sheets, then complete the table. You can use your own ideas too! Make sure that you write in first person (using ‘I’, and ‘me’), as you are going to pretend to be Robert when you write the story.
<u>Tuesday</u> <u>29.6.21</u>		Write the capacity shown in each container. Then write how many millilitres are in each amount. Remember, 1000ml = 1L.	Read and discuss ‘Jade’s Party’ again. Write a summary of the story. Remember, a summary only includes the main points. Use the sentence starters to help you.	Read the slide about how Robert and Nita are getting fed up of cleaning. Discuss your ideas with someone else in your house, about what they might say to each other. Then, over the next 2 days, you are going to draw a comic strip to show their conversation. Remember to draw speech bubbles to show what they say!
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>30.6.21</u>		Complete the ‘number line positions’ activity. If you find it too hard to draw a number line, use the blank number lines provided on the next page. You might want to use more than one copy of this template for the next 3 days.	Read and discuss ‘Living Dinosaurs’, p1-8, with someone else in your house.	
<u>Thursday</u> <u>1.7.21</u>		Draw the number lines as directed. Then, work out what number is being pointed at on each number line.	Read p1-8 of ‘Living Dinosaurs’ again. Answer the questions about the text. Remember to look back at the text to find the answers!	Today you are going to rewrite your conversation between Robert and Nita using inverted commas. Read the information about inverted commas in the PowerPoint first, so you know what to do. Then rewrite your conversation using the correct punctuation. Don’t forget to use ‘I’ and ‘we’ when writing, as you are pretending to be Robert!
<u>Friday</u> <u>2.7.21</u>	Complete a spelling test of the some of the words that you have practiced this week.	Round the numbers to the nearest 100. Remember, if the number ends in 1-49, you round it down; if it ends in 50-99, you round it up. Then, work out which number is being pointed at on each number line.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.	Look at the example story ideas. Then rewrite your ideas for your story using the planning template. Think about what will happen in each part. Remember, this is just a plan – not the whole story – so you only need to make notes!
