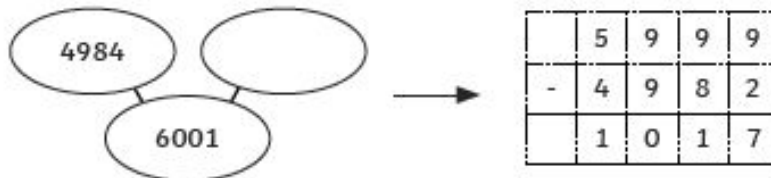


- 1) Read this word problem and choose either a number line, the compensation method or column subtraction with exchanging to solve it. Explain why you chose this method.



Mr Woods has an £8000 to buy a new car. He bought a car for £6798. How much money did he have left?

- 2) Rosalie is trying to solve the part-whole model below.



She asks her friend Neil to check her work.

This is incorrect. You have written the calculation down wrong. It should be $6001 - 4984$, not $5999 - 4982$.



Do you agree or disagree with his comment? Explain your reasoning.

- 3) Orla has chosen to count on using a number line to complete this calculation. Check her work and correct any mistakes. Explain what Orla has done wrong.

$$7980 - 7049 = 940$$
