Practice the ‘ou’ sound and read the linked words. Read ‘Our house’ and discuss the story with someone else in your house.	Read the example setting description. Then write your own version, describing the dark beach setting picture on the next page. Use the writing prompts and sentence starters to help you.
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>19.5.21</u>	choose a word from the spelling list. Can your partner spell the word correctly?	Find half of the numbers. Then complete the outputs from the halving machine. Challenge: Halve the odd numbers.	Read ‘Our house’ again. Then create a poster about your own house! You could draw pictures and write about things such as who lives there, what your house looks like, what you like to do in your house etc.	Read your writing from yesterday. Think about how you might edit and improve it, using a different coloured pen. Make changes, then rewrite your final draft in your best handwriting.
<u>Thursday</u> <u>20.5.21</u>	Choose a word from the spelling list. Can you use it in a sentence, spelling the word correctly? Repeat 4 more times.	Find the fractions of the shapes and the amounts.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.
