<u>Monday</u> <u>24.5.21</u>	Practice reading and spelling the words ending in ‘ous’.	Find half of the numbers by partitioning (halve the tens, then the ones, then add your answers together).	Read ‘Fairtrade’ and discuss the text with someone in your house. Answer the questions about it.	Over the last few weeks we have completed a lot of writing linked to the topic of the seaside. Today you are going to create an acrostic poem about the seaside. This is a poem where the topic word is down the side, and each line starts with the letter used in that word. <u>Tuesday</u> <u>25.5.21</u>		Find the fractions of the shapes. Remember, each part of the shape should be the same size for the fraction to be correct.	Read ‘Our house’ and discuss the story with someone else in your house. Answer the questions about it.	Today you are going to create a shape poem all about the seaside. Look at the PowerPoint about shape poems to understand what they look like. You could write about what you might see or do at the seaside. Your poem must be in a shape that links to the topic. Then create your own shape poem, either using one of the templates provided, or by creating your own shape.
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>26.5.21</u>		Find the fractions of the amounts. You can use the fraction strips, objects or drawing pictures to help you if you need it.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.	Today you are going to create a poem about the seaside using your senses. What might you see/hear/smell/feel/taste there? Look at the PowerPoint of photos to help you, then write your poem using your ideas.
<u>Thursday</u> <u>27.5.21</u> Elmer day	Complete a spelling test of the some of the words that you have practiced this week.	Work out the answers to the addition and subtraction questions. Then colour the picture of Elmer using the correct colours.	Choose a book to read on Bug Club. Answer the questions about it.	Listen to the story ‘Elmer’ at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TUepS9yGANQ Think about what Elmer is unique (different) to everyone else. What makes you unique? Think about what you are good at, what your personality is like, what makes you stand out etc.
