Activity: using the information from the slides can you write a sentence or two about each part of the period of Easter? EG: Lent – A period of around 40 days where some Christians fast.

Then, look at the event cards on your screen and write them in the right order in your pink books. Now, create a timeline in your pink books and place events in the right date order along a timeline. <p><u>Friday</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u> Charanga <u>DT</u></p> <p>This week, you will be researching some designs for handkerchief dolls which were very common toys in the 1920's. Find some designs using research and draw one or two that you like in your pink book.</p> <p>Also, you need to start collecting materials to make either a teddy or a handkerchief doll. Remember, you are not making anything yet, only collecting materials.</p> <p><u>Teddy:</u> you might need a dark brown material for teddy outline, cotton wool for stuffing, buttons for eyes.</p> <p><u>handkerchief</u> doll- you will need a large handkerchief, buttons for eyes, felt tip pen to draw other face features of your toy.</p>
