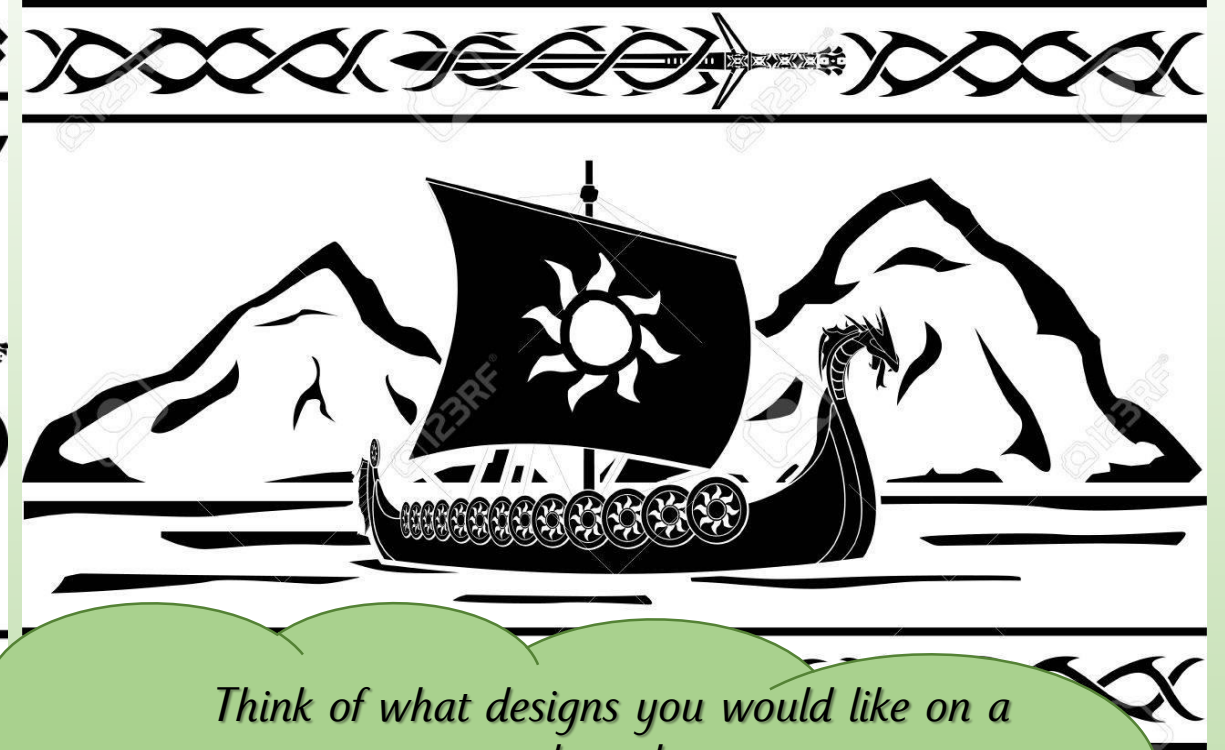
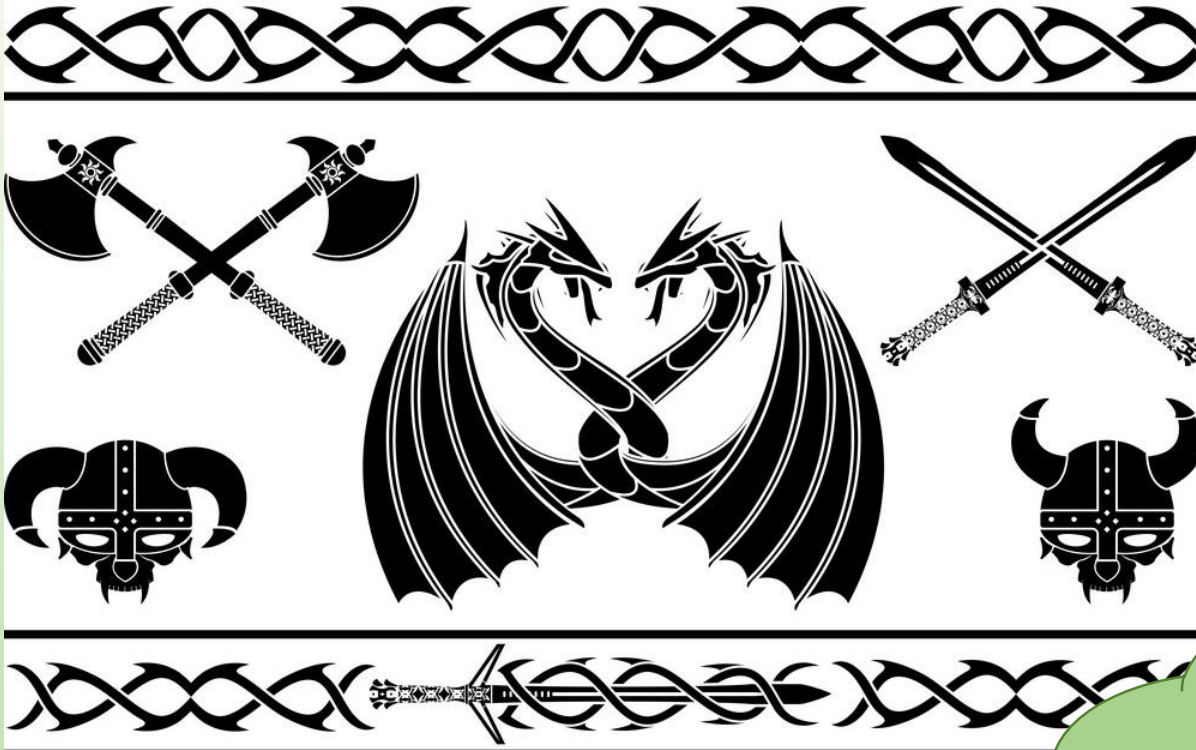
Viking jewellery



Viking jewellery was beautifully made, using materials ranging from gold to simple animal bones. Both **men** and **women** loved wearing jewellery. They wore rings, brooches, bracelets, and necklaces to show their status. The poor made their jewellery from bronze, pewter, or the bones of animals they ate for dinner, whereas the rich used precious silver and gold. Men wore a single brooch on their right shoulder, while women wore one on either shoulder to fasten their shawls. The Vikings picked up fashions in jewellery from the countries they visited and changed them to their own style. Many Viking ornaments featured images of animals, particularly the twisting shapes of snakes.
