LC: Can I draft a closing paragraph for newspaper report?

The closing paragraph should summarise the events so far. It should also explain what has happened since the event occurred, what is happening now and what will happen next.

Your closing paragraph should include:

- Formal language
- Referring to nouns using synonyms
- Prepositional phrases
- Past/present/future tenses
- Relative clauses
- Brackets

Remember that we draft on every other line to give us space to edit our writing.
