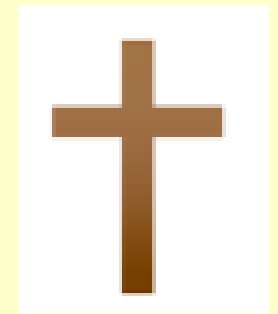


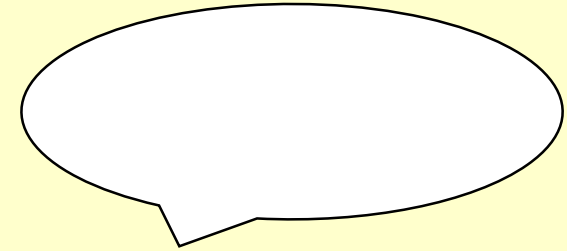
# LC: Can I discuss what values matter to me and to others?
