## Instructions:

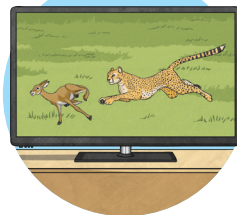
Read out the card to the class and ask whether they agree or disagree with each statement.

Leaving electronic items on standby is useful because it is much quicker to turn them on when you want to use them.

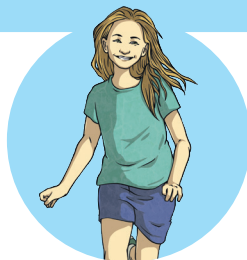


World Water Day

We should plant more trees around the world.



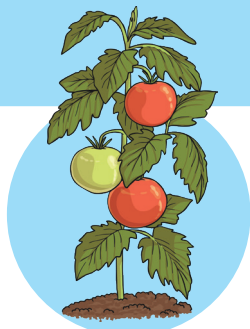
There's plenty of water for everyone so why are we worried?



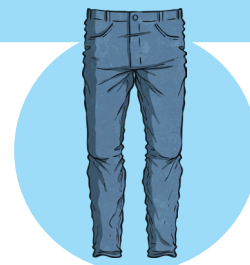
If you have access to clean water, you don't have anything to worry about.
