Underline any vocabulary you do not understand and use a dictionary to find the meaning.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Listen to the story again using the link at the bottom of the timetable. You are going to sequence the story. You can either print the worksheet out and cut and stick the sentences in the correct order or you can write the sentences in the correct order.</p>	<p><u>Spellings:</u> On the website - practice them each day. Look up the meaning of any words you do not understand.
