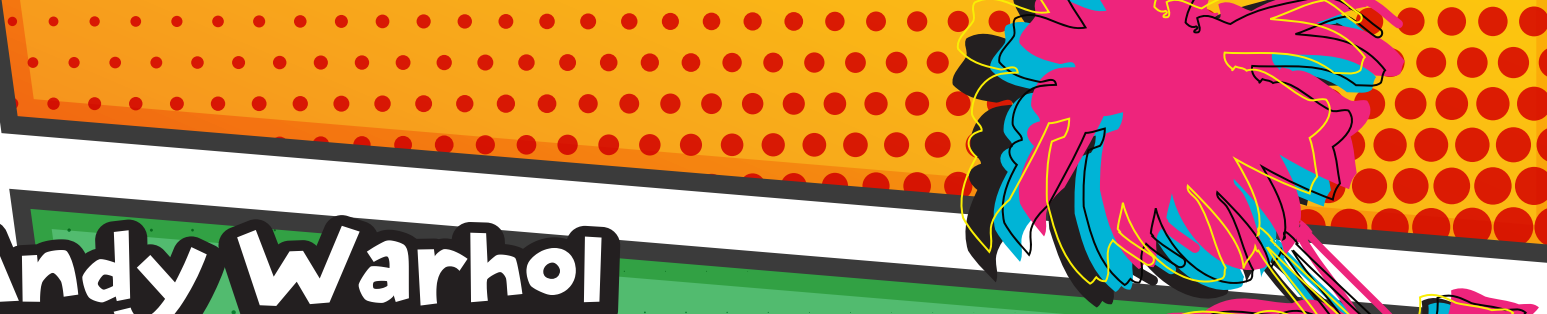
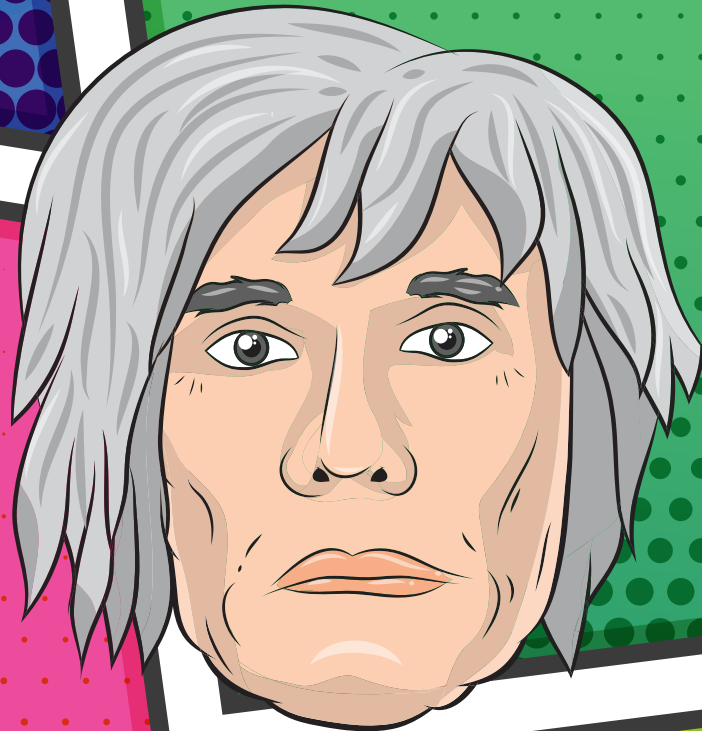


Andy Warhol

Andy Warhol was born on 6th August 1928.

He often used a range of media, which included painting, silk-screening, photography, film and sculpture.

Warhol's work explored the relationships between celebrities, advertising and artistic expression

He was an American artist, director and producer.

Pop Art

This artistic technique is **based on modern popular culture**.

It includes:

- **Simple, solid lines**
- **Oversized images or objects**
- **Bright colours**
- **Collages (repetition) of popular images**



Repetition



Andy Warhol often repeated the same image, to add effect to his work.
He changed the colours of the images to develop his Pop Art style.

Some of his most famous portraits included repeated images of famous people.

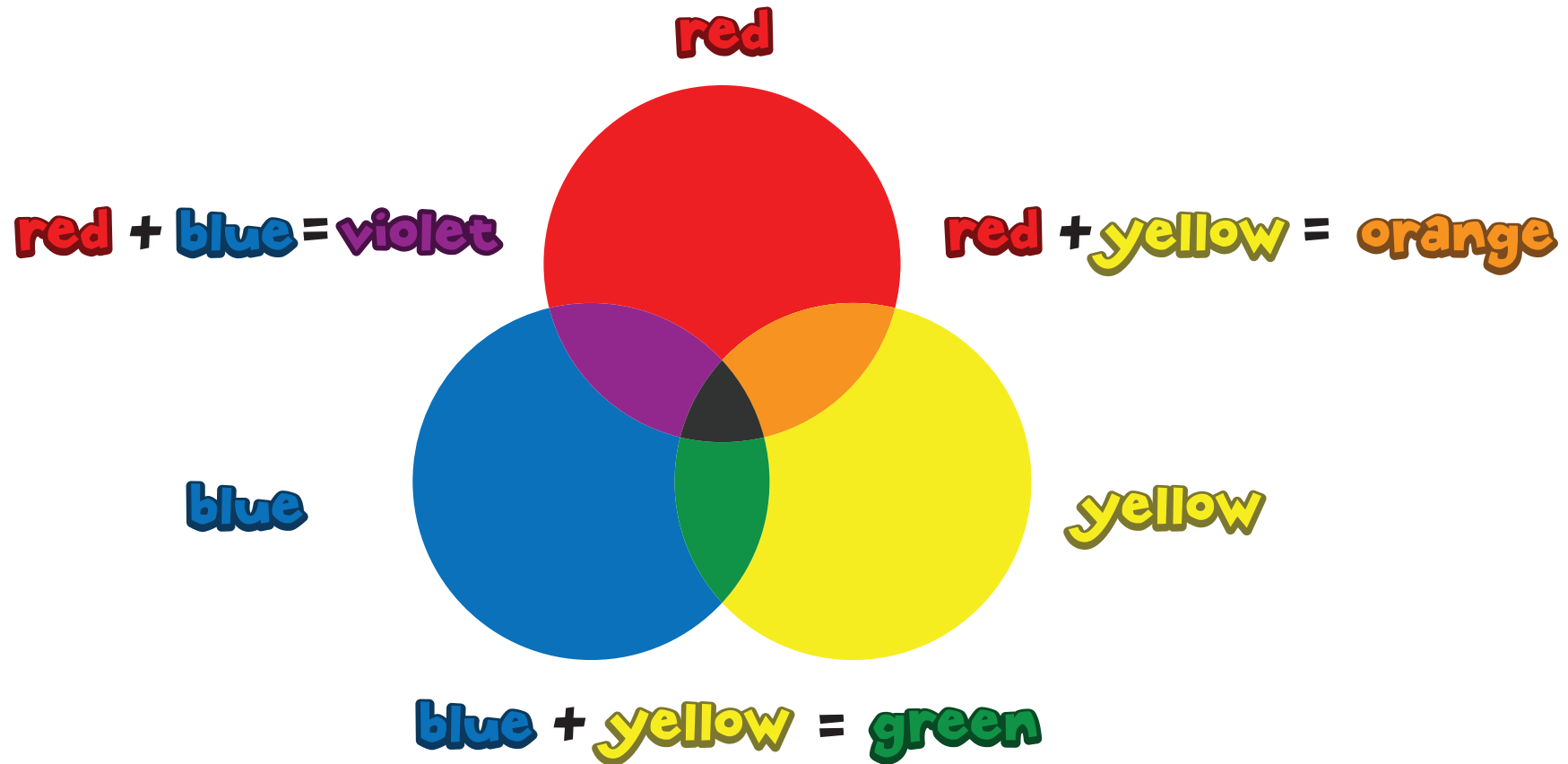
