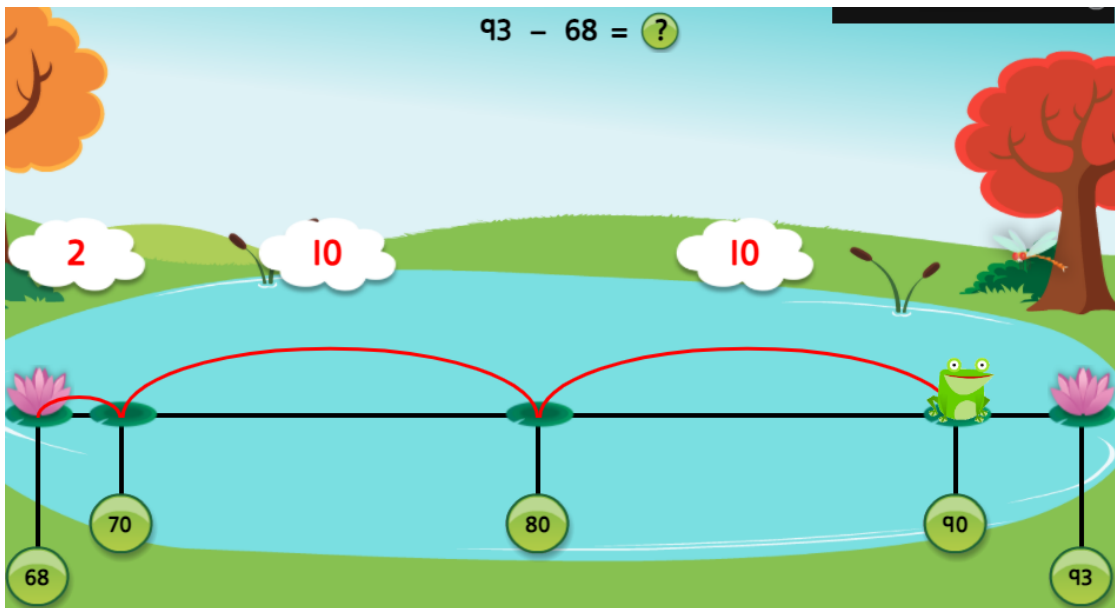

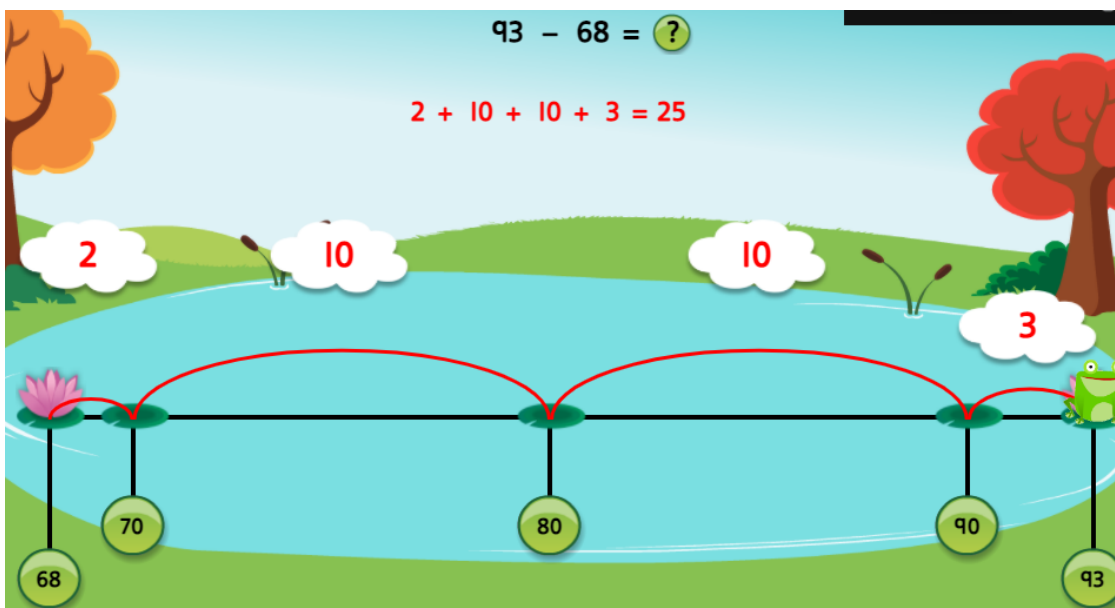
First you need to make sure that you have the smallest number at the beginning of the number line. This is because you are going to count up to the larger number to work out the difference.



Frog will jump to the next ten. This means he is jumping to the number 70.



Next Frog will jump in 10s until he gets to the nearest 10 to the larger number. For this example, Frog has to stop at 90.



Finally he will jump to 93. Then you have to add up the amount Frog has jumped so the answer is 25.
