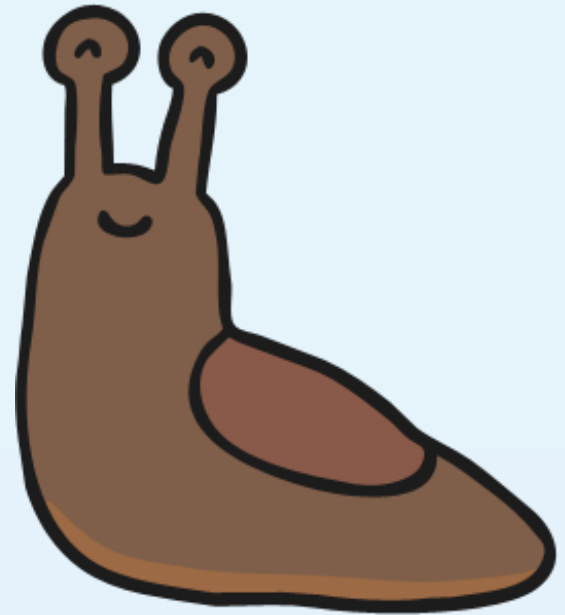


There was a **huge, hairy** spider

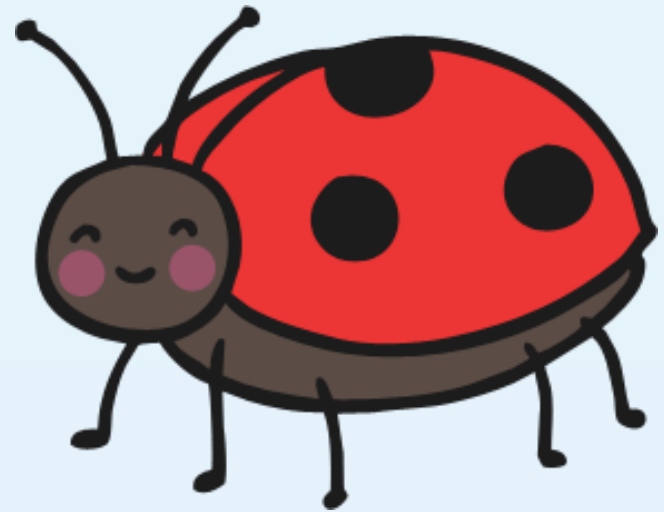
A **slimy, sticky** slug was

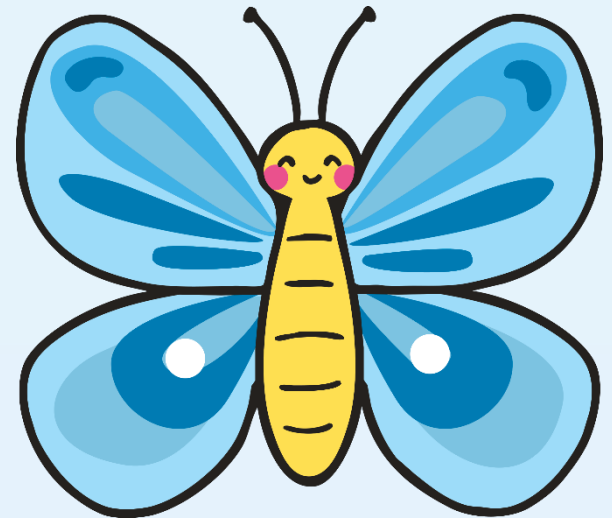
I found a **tiny** ladybird
