“We are just getting wood. “Wait here,” she said.



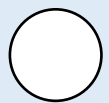
“Let’s just **wait** a bit longer,” **said** Hansel.

**a**re **b**ait!”

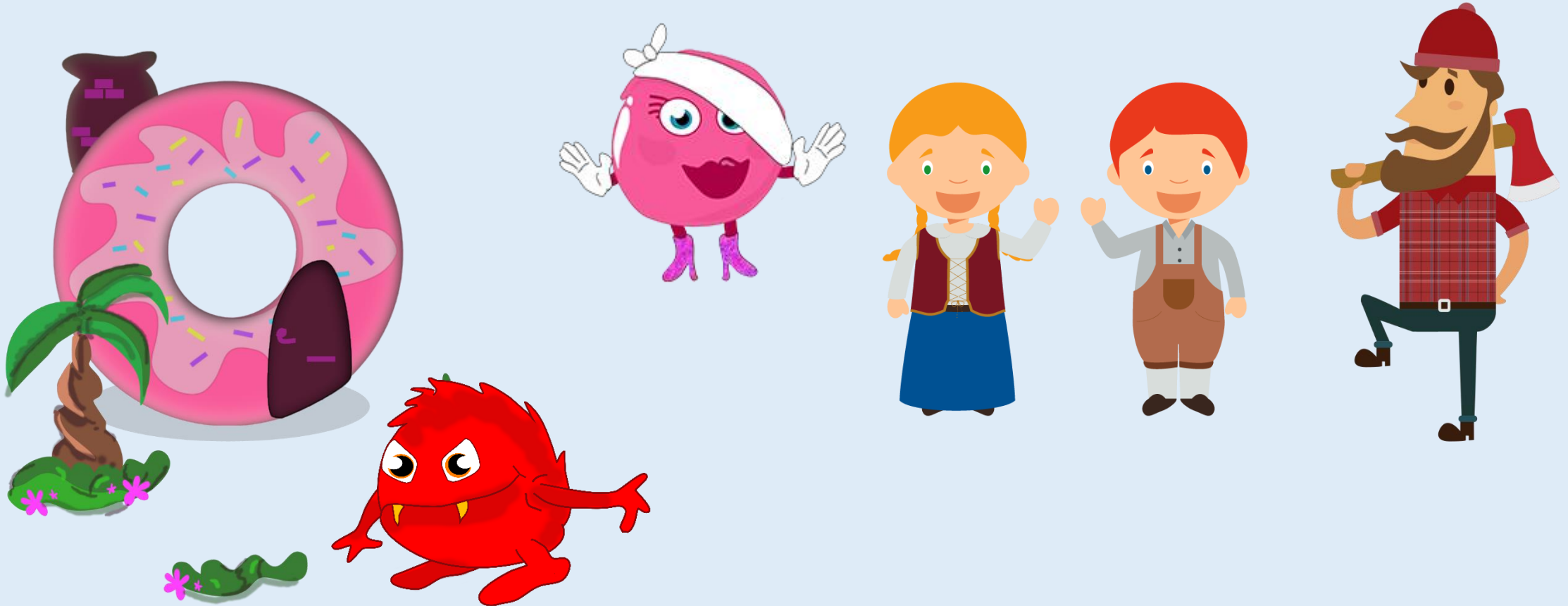
“Miss Oh No’s **house** **is** a short **drive**,” **he** **said**,
