

<p>Monday</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Today you are going to continue to practice adding 1 and 2 digit numbers. You need to answer the questions on the sheet and see if you can spot a pattern. Then you need to use this knowledge to work out an addition using a 3-digit number.</p>	<p><u>Guided Reading</u> Read the text. Underline any vocabulary you do not understand and use a dictionary to find the meaning.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Think about a time where you may have had a friendship problem. (E.g. best friend left your school, friend doesn't want to play with you, you've got no one to play with at play time etc.). Write what the problem could be, and what your solution would be to solve this. Use your word mats and sentence starters to help you.</p>	<p><u>Spellings:</u> On the website - practice them each day. Look up the meaning of any words you do not understand. Choose a few words from the list each day and use them in a sentence.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u> Today we are going to be looking at how the Stone Age people would have communicated. Split your page in half and write down all the ways we can communicate on one side of your page (e.g. talking, phone calls, text messages, etc.). Research how Stone Age people would have communicated and list these on the other side of your page.</p>

Think about the hundreds, tens and ones when you are completing the questions.</p>	<p><u>Guided Reading</u> Have a look at the questions, underline the important parts of the questions.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Read the story - Sand Wizards. Using what you have read, answer the questions about the story using the sentence starters to help you.</p>	<p>Choose a few words from the list each day and use them in a sentence.</p>	<p><u>RE</u> Today you are going to look at how Christians use the bible. The bible may be used for weddings, funerals, readings in church, vicar's talks, hymns, group discussion, parents reading children stories and many more. Divide your page in three, draw a picture and write a caption showing three different ways the Bible is used.</p>
