Try starting with <math>11+88=99</math>.</p>	<p><u>Guided Reading</u> Read the text. Underline any vocabulary you do not understand and use a dictionary to find the meaning.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Today you are going to look at expanded noun phrases. Look at the picture. Write expanded noun phrases from what you can see in the picture. For example - the green bottle. Challenge - Can you write an expanded noun phrase including a simple preposition? For example - The large sunflower was <b>behind</b> the green bottle.</p>	<p><u>Spellings:</u>  On the website - practice them each day.  Look up the meaning of any words you do not understand.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u> Today you are going to look at Stone Age homes. Look at the PowerPoint. Think about everything you have learnt about the bible. Use the worksheet to help you.</p>

Use your knowledge of what we have learnt about greetings in French. <u>Computing</u> Try some of the computing activities on Purple Mash. <u>PE</u> Create a routine using balances, rolls, levels and travelling sequences.</p>
